

TITLE: Outstanding Achievement Award for
Certificate Program Graduates

CATEGORY: POLICY

PURPOSE: To recognize the academic and extracurricular achievements of graduates of the Mohawk College certificate programs (minimum of 180 hours) which are approved by the Ministry of Education and Training and/or the Board of Governors.

CRITERIA

The Outstanding Achievement Award for Certificate Program Graduates is awarded by Mohawk College, when merited, to graduates of certificate programs who achieve distinction in every segment of College life and demonstrate traits which set an example for fellow students. Such students will have maintained a high academic standing and will have contributed to the enhancement of College and community life. Recipients would normally be Honours Graduates but this Award may be presented if other criteria are sufficiently strong. While there is no limit to the number awarded in any academic year, the College will not present an Outstanding Achievement Award for Certificate Program Graduates unless justified.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The Selection Committee - Outstanding Achievement Award for Certificate Program Graduates, appointed by the President, will receive nominations from staff and students through the Chairs of certificate programs. The Committee, through its Chair, will make recommendations in confidence to the President for approval.

PRESENTATION

Outstanding Achievement Awards for Certificate Program Graduates will be presented at an appropriate Convocation/Graduation Ceremony.
